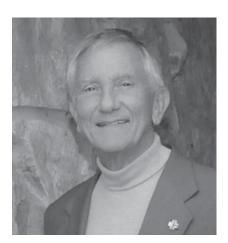
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Dear Friends of the Hermitage:

AUTUMN

I think we are living in a very exciting time. All of us are involved in a huge kind of change that has never happened before in human history. We are living through changes in the global economy. Organized religion seems to be falling apart. Leaders the world over are looking for solutions to war and poverty. Family structures are collapsing. Climate change is creating fires, floods, and volcanic eruptions.

The media reports these changes as "disasters" and are leaving the impression that this is a terrible time in which to live. But there are other ways of looking at these changes and events. The professionals in science, religion, sociology, and economics, for example, give us the impression that this is an exciting time in which to live.

How can it be that one person looks at the situation and sees it as negative and another person looks at the very same situation and sees it as positive? The answer is simple: *Your thoughts create your reality!* That's right, what you think becomes reality for you.

In my work, I see more and more people understanding this principle and, as they change their thoughts, they change their experience. For example, the immature behavior of our Congress over the past few months is helping the people of our country (as well as the people of the world) move into a different thought process. We are beginning to understand that, instead of dual thinking - "either-or" and "us-them," - it is far more productive to use the non-dual thinking of "both-and" or "community."

Non-dual thinking is the challenge given to us by Jesus, Buddha, and all the great religious leaders. "I pray, Father, they may be one, as You and I are one. That they may be one is us!" When will we learn that this is the kind of thinking that creates love and produces peace, both in our personal lives and in the world round us?

Think how great it would be if both right and left, Democrat and Republican, traditional medicine and alternative medicine, East and West, could take the best of both sides and create systems that would help improve the quality of life for all. Think how good it could be if people were able to think in terms of dialogue, rather than litigation. Imagine how exciting it would be when all of us turn our thoughts to solutions, instead of pointing fingers, making judgments, and creating war.

Just today I got an email from one of my students in Australia. She was telling me of a relationship that has been broken for 30 years. In meditation, she was able to see that there was fault on both sides of the relationship. Using Ho'Oponopono meditation and the mantra, "I am sorry, please forgive me," she began to feel love and compassion for the other person. She pictured Continued on Page 2

herself and the other person in Divine Light, both of them an extension of Divine Love. Then one day, at a family gathering, both were forced to be together. She approached the other person, began a conversation, expressed regret for the past, and thanked her for the good things that she had done and continues to do for her family. The other person responded in a loving way and the friendship was mended. After a long discussion, they realized that it was a third party that caused the rift in their friendship. Now, together, they are working to mend other relationships in the family. In this case, both parties changed their thoughts from "either-or" to "both-and." Fault was on both sides, but now they are both in the space of love and friendship.

In my own life, I discovered long ago that God dwells both in me and in every other person. When I am conscious of this fact, I can love everyone. Also, I know that I cannot have all truth, so when I am listening to someone who has a different viewpoint from mine, I can really *listen* and learn from what the other person is saying, expand my awareness, and love the other person where he/she might be. When putting on white clothing every Wednesday, I tell myself, "Justin, if you want to promote peace, it is important to be loving and compassionate. It is not important to be 'right." With that kind of thinking, I can love everyone who enters my life.

If you want to get a deeper understanding of the "both-and" spirituality described above, please take time to read and study *Success: Full Relating*. My purpose in writing this volume was to help individuals understand the difference between "either-or" (dual) spirituality and "both-and" (non-dual) spirituality. Peace will come into our lives and into our world only when we begin to think in a way that is unitive.

The principle I use is this: Know what you believe and live what you believe. Then, help others to know what they believe and allow them to live the way they believe. This is a principle that can create love and compassion in you and bring peace to our world.

Times are indeed changing, and they are changing for the better. More and more individuals are moving into a more mature spirituality as expressed in a "both-and" approach. I invite you to shift your thought process into this inclusive model and put those thoughts and that model into your life. Inclusive spirituality is moving the entire population of Planet Earth towards the reality of a Global Village and a Universal Human Family. Be a part of this important movement. **You can make a difference.**
